We are also very concerned with the cracks that have formed on the courts, not only at Marshall Field but other courts in Vernon. We are presently communicating with the City about these concerns.

For our junior development program for the coming year, I plan to meet with some parents in January to discuss setting up a spring program. Over the past summer we had 53 registrations in the lessons at Marshall Field. There is certainly an interest in tennis with the younger generation.



TENNIS TIT-BIT

Origin of the Yellow Ball – Historically, balls were either white or black in colour depending on the background colour of the courts. In 1972 the ITF introduced yellow tennis balls in the rules of tennis, as research had shown these balls to be more visible to television viewers.
