We certainly still see a need for more courts at Marshall Field and feel the 2004 and 2015 Vernon City Parks Reports also indicate this. This year the total tennis membership in the Kal Club, Predator Ridge and the VTA was 331. The Kal Club and Predator have closed their memberships. The City morning tennis programs also had 81 players thus giving a total of 412 adult registrations in these organizations. Our summer junior lessons were maxed out with 56 registrations while the present Predator junior lessons are also maxed out with 60 registrations. Not included are the registrations in the City lessons or the high performance juniors at Predator. Tennis is alive and well in Vernon, and we are certainly looking to build our club further in 2024.

## VERNON JUNIOR TENNIS GETS SUPPORT
